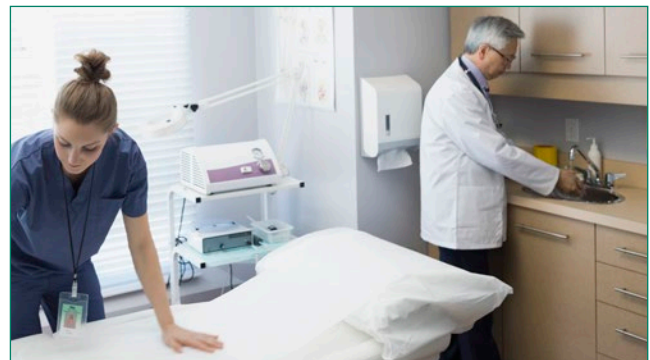
Almost 80% of infectious diseases are transmitted via touch
